Dorota Haman is Professor Emeritus of the Agricultural and Biological Engineering Department at the University of Florida. She received a BS degree in Mathematics from University of Warsaw in Poland. Her M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Agricultural Engineering are from Michigan State University. Her research projects are focused on water conservation and implementation of water efficient technologies including microirrigation. She has been at UF since 1985 and retired in 2018 after serving for 11 years as department chair.

Fedro Zazueta is Professor Emeritus of the Agricultural and Biological Engineering Department at the University of Florida. He obtained a B.S. degree in Civil Engineering and an M.S. in Mechanical Engineering and Agronomy from the Tecnológico de Monterrey, Mexico. He obtained his Ph.D. in Agricultural Engineering from Colorado State University. Zazueta joined the UF Agricultural Engineering Department as a visiting assistant professor in 1982, where he remained for 36 years. With the vision of a “desktop computer in every farm”, Zazueta developed research, teaching and extension programs that focused on the use of computers in agriculture. During the last 20 years of his tenure at UF, he served developing and implementing the Institutional IT Strategic Plans.
