WHOM DO WE SERVE?

Floridians with a disability or long-term health condition who reside on a farm/ranch, or who are engaged in farming, fishing, or forestry may be eligible for AgrAbility services.

Examples of a disability include, but are not limited to:

- Amputation
- Back impairment
- Developmental disabilities
- Mental/behavioral health problems
- Spinal cord injuries
- Traumatic brain injury
- Arthritis
- Deafness / Hearing impairment
- Disabling diseases
- Respiratory diseases
- Stroke Visual impairments

- Conduct worksite assessments to identify barriers to completing tasks both in the agriculture workplace and at home
- Make recommendations for overcoming disability-related limitations including assistive technologies, modified work practices, & other possible solutions
