Land use

- Soil and weather conditions are favorable to the cultivation of food crops that are sold to nearby markets or processed as flour grains
- A third of the population works in the agricultural sector. Gold deposits have encouraged mining activities

Urbanization

- The District has experienced rapid urbanization fueled by its proximity to Kumasi and strategic location on the Accra-Kumasi road
- More than 60% of the population lives in cities, including 50,000 people in Konongo, the district capital

- Forests have become more fragmented in the last two decades. Large portions of degraded forest are now cultivated
